- 2) The offers should reach on (or) before the last date and time prescribed.
- 3) Tender Schedule is not transferable.

- 5) **“Nurseries having registered and obtained license from Horticulture Dept under Nursery Act 2010”** i.e., **Andhra Pradesh Registration of Horticulture Nurseries (Regulation) Act 2010 (ACT No.13 OF 2010)** and having a minimum experience of (3) years in production and supply of different kinds of fruit plant material to the State /Central Govt.
